1 the unsworn statement in writing of the person made and signed under penalty of perjury setting forth the date and place of execution and 2 3 that it is made under the laws of Oklahoma this state. The statement under penalty of perjury may be substantially in the 4 5 following form: "I state under penalty of perjury under the laws of Oklahoma 6 7 that the foregoing is true and correct. 8 9 (Date and Place) (Signature)" 10 The signed statement under penalty of perjury shall constitute a legally binding assertion that the contents of the statement to 11 12 which it refers are true. This section shall not affect any requirement for acknowledgment of an instrument affecting real 13 property. 14 B. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not 15 16 apply to: 1. A deposition; 17 2. Any oath of office; 18 3. An oath required to be taken before a specified official 19 other than a notary public; or 20 Any notarial act, oath or affidavit required by Title 26 of 21 4. the Oklahoma Statutes. 22 23 24
