L3	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

L 6	A. In all instances in which the Office of Management and
L7	Enterprise Services changes a policy affecting a state agency, the
L8	Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall provide the
L 9	affected agency with written notice no fewer than thirty (30) days
20	in advance of the policy's implementation.
21	B. During the period after an affected agency has been
22	notified, and prior to the implementation of the policy, the
23	affected agency shall be permitted to respond to the Office of

Management and Enterprise Services and request to be exempted from

1	the policy change, or request modifications to the policy. The
2	affected agency shall be given a final notice in written format
3	explaining any changes to a policy prior to its implementation.
4	C. The provisions of this act shall not apply to any policy
5	changes made necessary by federal law or policy, or any other policy
6	changes deemed an emergency by the Office of Management and
7	Enterprise Services.
