SENATE BILL 59 By: Thompson

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AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to corrections; amending 57 O.S. 2011, Section 38, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 260, O.S.L. 2017 (57 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 38), which relates to jail reimbursement rate; providing certain consideration by the State Auditor; providing definition; prohibiting certain consideration; assigning burden of proof; permitting necessary procedures; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2011, Section 38, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 260, O.S.L. 2017 (57 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 38), is amended to read as follows:

Section 38. A. The Department of Corrections shall reimburse any county which is required to retain an inmate pursuant to subsection E of Section 37 of this title in an amount not to exceed Twenty-seven Dollars (\$27.00) per day for each inmate during such period of retention, unless the actual daily cost as determined by the Department of Corrections Daily Rate as defined or the State Auditor, in accordance with the procedures set forth in this section, exceeds Twenty-seven Dollars (\$27.00). If a county

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calculates that the actual daily cost as determined by the Department of Corrections Daily Rate exceeds Twenty-seven Dollars (\$27.00), the county shall notify the Department of Corrections of the actual daily cost no later than September 30. If the county's calculation of the actual daily cost is accepted by the Department that shall be the reimbursement rate for the county beginning the next fiscal year. If the Department rejects the county's actual daily cost application, then the actual daily cost reimbursement shall be determined by the State Auditor and shall be imposed beginning the next fiscal year.

- B. For purposes of this section, the "actual daily cost" is defined as the costs of feeding, housing, clothing and providing medical treatment to the inmate retained under subsection E of Section 37 of this title. Actual daily cost shall refer only to the incremental cost attributable to the presence of Department of Corrections inmates in the county jail and shall not include any jail-related or staffing-related fixed cost or expense incurred by the county regardless of the presence of the Department of Corrections inmates.
- C. The applicant county bears the burden to provide the State

 Auditor with sufficient information to allow the State Auditor to

 determine the county's actual daily cost. The State Auditor may

 specify additional procedures as necessary, provided such procedures

 comply with the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act.

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1 The Department shall distribute the reimbursement on a 2 monthly basis upon receipt and approval of a billing statement from 3 the county. The county shall use the reimbursement to defray expenses of equipping and maintaining the jail and payment of 5 personnel. The provisions in this act shall be implemented by the 6 Department to allow sufficient time for application to FY-2019. 7 Department of Corrections shall reimburse the county for the 8 emergency medical care for physical injury or illness of the inmate 9 retained under this act if the injury or illness is directly related 10 to the incarceration and the county is required by law to provide 11 such care for inmates in the jail. The Department shall not pay 12 fees for medical care in excess of the rates established for 13 Medicaid providers. The state shall not be liable for medical 14 charges in excess of the Medicaid scheduled rate. The Director may 15 accept any inmate required to have extended medical care upon 16 application of the county. 17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021. 18 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 19 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 21

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be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
