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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to insurance; defining terms;
8 requiring coverage for retrieval in certain
9 circumstances; specifying terms of coverage;
10 providing for codification; and providing an
11 effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.8b of Title 36, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. For the purposes of this section:

17 1. "Health benefit plan" means any plan or arrangement as
18 defined in subsection C of Section 6060.4 of Title 36 of the
19 Oklahoma Statutes;

20 2. "Iatrogenic infertility" means an impairment of fertility by
21 surgery, radiation, chemotherapy, or other medical treatment for the
22 diagnosis of cancer; and
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1 3. "Retrieval" means ovulation induction and procedure to
2 obtain the eggs or sperm. The term "retrieval" shall not include
3 subsequent storage, disposition, fertilization, and transplantation.

4 B. Any health benefit plan, including the Oklahoma Employees
5 Insurance Plan, that is offered, issued, or renewed in this state on
6 or after the effective date of this act shall provide coverage for
7 the retrieval of eggs or sperm in a covered person who will receive
8 a medically necessary treatment including but not limited to
9 surgery, chemotherapy, and radiation, that has been medically
10 determined to cause iatrogenic infertility.

11 C. The coverage provided by this section shall be subject to
12 the same annual deductibles, copayments, or coinsurance limits as
13 established for all covered benefits under the health benefit plan.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2024.
