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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 359, O.S.L.
16	2017 (74 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 150.9.1), is amended to read as
17	follows:
18	Section 150.9.1. The Oklahoma Tax Commission, Oklahoma
19	Department of Human Services and Oklahoma Employment Security
20	Commission shall be authorized to require agency employees and the
21	employees of agency contractors in positions that have access to
22	Federal Tax Information and data to supply all information and
23	documentation required in order to be subjected to a criminal
24	history search by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, as

1	well as be fingerprinted for submission of the fingerprints through
2	the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to the Federal Bureau of
3	Investigation for a national criminal history check. The applicable
4	employer-agency submitting agency shall be the recipient of the
5	results of the record check. In accordance with Section 150.9 of
6	Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, this includes a national criminal
7	record with a fingerprint analysis.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
