6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to school athletic associations;  
8 amending Section 3, Chapter 327, O.S.L. 2014 (70 O.S.  
9 Supp. 2016, Section 27-103), which relates to the  
10 Oklahoma Extracurricular Activities Accountability  
11 Act; prohibiting schools or districts that are  
12 members of certain association from receiving state-  
13 appropriated funding unless the association has  
14 adopted certain policy; requiring policy to address  
15 certain district alignments; providing an effective  
16 date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 327, O.S.L.  
2014 (70 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 27-103), is amended to read as  
follows:

Section 27-103. A public school or school district ~~shall not be~~  
that is a member of any school athletic association shall not  
receive any state-appropriated funds, including but not limited to  
State Aid calculated pursuant to Section 18-200.1 of this title  
unless that association has adopted a written policy that requires  
the following:

1 1. All records of the association to be made accessible  
2 consistent with the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Records Act;

3 2. All meetings of the association to be open and conducted in  
4 a manner consistent with the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Meeting  
5 Act, including specifically the notice and agenda, voting and  
6 executive session requirements; ~~and~~

7 3. An annual financial audit and a compliance audit of all  
8 funds of the association in accordance with the auditing standards  
9 set forth in the Oklahoma Public School Audit Law. In addition, the  
10 association shall have performance audits conducted of the  
11 operations of the association. A performance audit shall be  
12 conducted no later than December 31, 2014, and by December 31 every  
13 five (5) years thereafter; and

14 4. District alignments in which the largest class of schools is  
15 exclusively comprised of high schools in which the average daily  
16 attendance is greater than two thousand two hundred fifty (2,250)  
17 students and the school district has only one (1) high school.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
20 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
