SENATE BILL 667

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Retail Electric Supplier Certified Territory Act; amending 17 O.S. 2021, Section 158.25, which relates to exclusive rights within territory; providing for certain retail electric supplier's ability to extend service under certain circumstances; updating statutory references; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 17 O.S. 2021, Section 158.25, is amended to read as follows:

Section 158.25. A. Except as otherwise provided herein, each retail electric supplier shall have the exclusive right to furnish retail electric service to all electric-consuming facilities located within its certified territory, and shall not furnish, make available, render or extend its retail electric service to a consumer for use in electric-consuming facilities located within the certified territory of another retail electric supplier; provided that any retail electric supplier may extend its facilities through the certified territory of another retail electric supplier, if such extension is necessary for such supplier to connect any of its

3 B. Except as provided in ~~Section 5~~ subsections C and Section 5
4 E of this section, any new electric-consuming facility located in an
5 unincorporated area which has not as yet been included in a map
6 issued by the Commission, pursuant to ~~Section 4C(1)~~ 158.24 of this
7 title, or certified, pursuant to ~~Section 4-D~~ 158.24 of this title,
8 shall be furnished retail electric service by the retail electric
9 supplier which has an existing distribution line in closer proximity
10 to such electric-consuming facility than is the nearest existing
11 distribution line of any other retail electric supplier. Any
12 disputes under this ~~Section 5-B~~ subsection shall be resolved by the
13 Commission.

14 C. If the Commission, after hearing, shall determine that the
15 retail electric service being furnished or proposed to be furnished
16 by a retail electric supplier to an electric-consuming facility is
17 inadequate and is not likely to be made adequate, the Commission may
18 authorize another retail electric supplier to furnish retail
19 electric service to such facility.

20 D. Except as provided in ~~Section 5~~ subsection C of this
21 section, no retail electric supplier shall furnish, make available,
22 render or extend retail electric service to any electric-consuming
23 facility to which such service is being lawfully furnished by
24 another retail electric supplier on ~~the effective date of this act~~

1 September 10, 1971, or to which retail electric service is lawfully
2 commenced thereafter in accordance with this section by another
3 retail electric supplier.

4 E. The provisions of this act shall not preclude any retail
5 electric supplier from extending its service after ~~the effective~~
6 ~~date of this act~~ September 10, 1971, (1) to its own property and
7 facilities, in an unincorporated area, and (2) subject to ~~Section 5~~
8 subsection D of this section, to an electric-consuming facility
9 requiring electric service, in an unincorporated area, if the
10 connected load for initial full operation of such electric-consuming
11 facility is to be ~~1,000 kw~~ two thousand (2,000) kw or larger.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.

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
