11 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and  
12 entire bill and insert

17 ~~BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:~~

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-111.1 of Title 47, unless  
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 To protect religious freedom and to accommodate the strongly  
22 held religious beliefs of Oklahoma residents, the Department of  
23 Public Safety shall issue a nonbiometric Class D driver license or  
24 identification card to a qualified recipient, who requests an

1 exemption from biometric identification, upon certification by the  
2 Department that the issuance of a biometric Class D driver license  
3 or identification card would violate the tenets of the religion or  
4 religious beliefs of the person. Any applicant for a religious  
5 exemption shall not be required to provide any biometric sample with  
6 the exception of the signature of the applicant. The Department of  
7 Public Safety shall permanently delete, within seventy-two (72)  
8 hours, any facial image collected for the issuance of a new, renewal  
9 or replacement Class D driver license or identification card, issued  
10 to a qualified person under this exemption. The Department shall  
11 not disclose to any entity any image collected for such issuance  
12 without a warrant from a court of appropriate jurisdiction. The  
13 Department shall not create a hard copy from such an image and shall  
14 permanently delete within seventy-two (72) hours from all active,  
15 backup or archival databases any biometric sample, biometric data or  
16 biometric template that may have been previously collected from the  
17 applicant.

18 SECTION 2. REPEALER 47 O.S. 2011, Section 6-110.3, is  
19 hereby repealed.
