13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 17-103, as
14	amended by Section 1, Chapter 141, O.S.L. 2019 (70 O.S. Supp. 2020,
15	Section 17-103), is amended to read as follows:
16	Section 17-103. Except as provided in the Alternate Retirement
17	Plan for Comprehensive Universities Act, the membership of the
18	retirement system shall consist of the following:
19	(1) All classified personnel shall become members of the
20	retirement system as a condition of their employment;
21	(2) All full-time nonclassified optional personnel regularly
22	employed for more than one (1) year may join the Teachers'
23	Retirement System subject to the rules and regulations adopted
24	pursuant to this act. Subject to the outcome of the private letter

1 ruling request (2003) submitted by the Board of Trustees to the 2 Internal Revenue Service (2001), the retirement system shall permit 3 eligible nonclassified optional personnel who have ceased to make 4 otherwise required employee contributions after having made an 5 election to become a member of the retirement system to resume 6 employee contributions. No service shall be credited to any such 7 member for any period of time during which employee contributions 8 were not made;

9 (3) All persons who shall become classified personnel or who 10 are regularly employed in any school system as new classified 11 personnel after July 1, 1943, hereof, shall become members of the 12 retirement system as a condition of their employment;

(4) All other regular school employees may join the Teachers' Retirement System subject to the rules and regulations as may be adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Teachers' Retirement System;

16 (5) The Board of Trustees may, in its discretion, deny the 17 right to become members to any class of members whose compensation 18 is only partly paid by the state, or who is serving on a temporary 19 or other than per annum basis, and it also may, in its discretion, 20 make optional with members in any such class their individual 21 entrance into the retirement system;

(6) Should any member, with less than ten (10) years of teaching service in Oklahoma, in any period of six (6) consecutive years after becoming a member be absent from service more than five (5) years, withdraw his or her contributions, retire or die, he or she shall thereupon cease to be a member. The provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to any member of the Teachers' Retirement System who has been a member of such classes of military services as may be approved by the Board of Trustees, until a period of one and one-half (1 1/2) years from date of termination of such service shall have elapsed; and
