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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, State Question No. 781,
15	Initiative Petition No. 405, as adopted on November 8, 2016, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 631. A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury
18	a revolving fund to be designated the "County Community Safety
19	Investment Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject
20 21	to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received
	pursuant to Section 633 of Title 57 of the Oklahoma Statutes <u>this</u>
22	<u>title</u> .
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1 B. All monies appropriated and accruing to the credit of the 2 fund shall be budgeted and expended by the Office of Management and 3 Enterprise Services Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services for the sole purpose of providing funds to counties to 4 5 provide community rehabilitative programming, including but not limited to mental health and substance abuse services within the 6 counties. Funds shall be disbursed in proportion to county 7 population, as reported in the most recent census. 8

9 C. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants 10 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by 11 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise 12 Services for approval and payment.

D. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
Services <u>The Commissioner of Mental Health and Substance Abuse</u>
<u>Services</u> shall promulgate rules necessary to implement the
provisions of this act.

17SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.18SECTION 3.
