Understanding conflict resolution.

B. The Department may work with one or more nonprofit organizations that have proven expertise in the development of standards and curriculum and delivery of teacher professional development in social-emotional learning for the purposes of developing and providing guidelines, materials, resources and professional development.

C. The Board of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services shall promulgate rules necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
