9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 40, Chapter 366, O.S.L.
11 2016 (37A O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 2-128), is amended to read as
12 follows:

13 Section 2-128. A. An on-premises beer and wine license shall
14 authorize the holder thereof:

15 1. To purchase beer and wine in retail containers from the
16 holder of a wholesaler, beer distributor, small brewer self-
17 distribution or brewpub self-distribution license or as specifically
18 provided by law; and

19 2. To sell, offer for sale and possess beer and wine for on-
20 premises consumption only; provided, the holder of an on-premises
21 beer and wine license issued for an establishment which is also a
22 restaurant may purchase wine from a winemaker who is permitted and
23 has elected to self-distribute as provided in Article XXVIII A of the
24 Oklahoma Constitution.

1 B. Sales and service of beer and wine by holders of on-premises
2 beer and wine licenses shall be limited to the licensed premises of
3 the licensee unless the holder of the on-premises beer and wine
4 license also obtains a caterer license. An on-premises beer and
5 wine license shall only be issued in counties of this state where
6 the sale of alcoholic beverages by the individual drink for on-
7 premises consumption has been authorized. A separate license shall
8 be required for each place of business. No spirits shall be stored,
9 possessed or consumed on the licensed premises of an on-premises
10 beer and wine license, unless the premises also has a mixed beverage
11 license.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 2018.
