7 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

8 An Act relating to county districts; amending 19 O.S.
9 2011, Section 321, as amended by Section 1, Chapter
10 190, O.S.L. 2012 (19 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 321),
11 which relates to county commissioner districts;
12 modifying date of specific reapportionment
13 completion; updating statutory language; and
14 providing an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 321, as
17 amended by Section 1, Chapter 190, O.S.L. 2012 (19 O.S. Supp. 2020,
18 Section 321), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 321. A. Each county shall be divided by the board of
20 county commissioners into three (3) compact districts, as equal in
21 population as practicable and numbered respectively one, two, and
22 three. One commissioner shall be elected from each of ~~said~~ the
23 districts by the voters of the district, as provided for by law.

24 B. 1. Each county shall be reapportioned by the board of
county commissioners on or before October 1 following the final

1 official publication of the Federal Decennial Census to ~~the State of~~
2 ~~Oklahoma~~ this state for the purposes of legislative redistricting.
3 Provided, for purposes of the 2021 reapportionment of counties, each
4 county shall be reapportioned by the board of county commissioners
5 on or before November 30, 2021, following the final official
6 publication of the Federal Decennial Census to this state for the
7 purposes of legislative redistricting. The reapportionment shall be
8 recorded in a resolution adopted by the commissioners. The
9 resolution shall include an effective date for the reapportioned
10 county commissioner districts. The effective date shall be January
11 1 of the following year.

12 2. Beginning with the reapportionment following the 1990
13 Federal Decennial Census, all boundaries of county commissioner
14 districts shall follow clearly visible, definable and observable
15 physical boundaries which are based upon criteria established and
16 recognized by the Bureau of the Census of the United States
17 Department of Commerce for purposes of defining census blocks for
18 its decennial census.

19 3. If the commissioners fail to reapportion the county as
20 required by this subsection, the commissioners shall be subject to
21 the provisions of Sections 91 through 105 of Title 51 of the
22 Oklahoma Statutes and it shall be the duty of the county excise
23 board to perform the reapportionment.

1 C. There is hereby established a depository for county
2 commissioner district boundary maps and reapportionment resolutions
3 within the Office of Geographic Information within the Oklahoma
4 Conservation Commission.

5 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
