6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to delinquent juvenile acts;
8 designating certain acts as delinquent juvenile acts;
9 requiring formulation of rehabilitation plan upon
10 certain referral; requiring certain notice and
11 hearing; authorizing court to accept or modify
12 certain plan; authorizing court to restrict or
13 suspend certain driving privileges; providing for
14 codification; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-8-225 of Title 10A, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. It shall be a delinquent act for a juvenile to:

20 1. Make a false report concerning an explosive or incendiary
21 device as defined in Section 1767.3 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
22 Statutes;

23 2. Perpetrate a hoax concerning an explosive or incendiary
24 device; or

25 3. Conspire to make a false report or perpetrate a hoax
26 concerning an explosive or incendiary device.

1 B. Upon adjudication, the court having jurisdiction over an act
2 described in subsection A of this section shall refer the juvenile
3 to the Juvenile Bureau or the Office of Juvenile Affairs to
4 formulate a plan of rehabilitation. Such rehabilitation plan shall
5 be considered by the court at a dispositional hearing after notice
6 is given to all parties. The state and the juvenile shall have the
7 opportunity to be heard at the dispositional hearing. The court may
8 modify or adopt the plan after such notice and hearing.
9 Additionally, the court may impose restrictions upon or suspend the
10 juvenile's driving privileges.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
