6 An Act relating to liability insurance policies;  
7 amending 36 O.S. 2011, Section 3625, which relates to  
8 annulment of liability policies; modifying  
9 applicability of certain provisions; and providing an  
10 effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 36 O.S. 2011, Section 3625, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 3625. A. No insurance contract insuring against loss  
15 or damage through legal liability for the bodily injury or death by  
16 accident of any individual, or for damage to the property of any  
17 person, shall be retroactively annulled by any agreement between the  
18 insurer and the insured after the occurrence of any such injury,  
19 death, or damage for which the insured may be liable, and any such  
20 attempted annulment shall be void.

21 B. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not  
22 apply to a claim made and reported from a liability insurance policy  
23 unless there is actual notice that a claim or potential claim has

1 been made against an insured who shall have also reported the claim  
2 or potential claim to the insured's insurer.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
