6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state employees; permitting  
8 agencies to adopt certain policies relating to  
9 physical fitness; specifying eligibility; providing  
10 certain limitation; directing promulgation of rules;  
11 providing for codification; and providing an  
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1385 of Title 74, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. Each agency, board, commission or other entity of state  
18 government may adopt policies permitting employees to use leave  
19 accrued pursuant to Section 840-2.20 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma  
20 Statutes for the purposes of physical fitness and wellness.

21 B. The provisions of this section shall:

- 22 1. Be eligible only for full-time equivalent employees;
- 23 2. Contingent upon approval by the employees' immediate  
24 supervisor or agency director; and
3. Be limited to no more than five (5) hours per week.

1 C. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
2 Services shall promulgate rules for forms and procedures for each  
3 agency to implement the provisions of this section.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective in accordance with  
5 the provision of Section 58 of Article V of the Oklahoma  
6 Constitution.
