SENATE BILL 822

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to welfare programs; defining term; prohibiting this state and any political subdivision of this state from providing universal basic income; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 270 of Title 56, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. As used in this section, "universal basic income" means any welfare program that provides a recurring source of income in the form of a government transfer payment to all residents or citizens or all adult residents or citizens within a designated area or political boundary, which income is provided without a means test or work requirement.

B. No universal basic income shall be provided by this state or any political subdivision of this state.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
