BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-502.5 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The State Department of Health or an agent of the Department shall not enter immunization records or other data of an individual into any database or system including, but not limited to, the Oklahoma State Immunization Information System without the prior written informed consent of the individual or, in the case of a minor child, the prior written informed consent of the minor child's parent or guardian.

The State Department of Health or an agent of the Department shall not share any immunization records or other data of an individual entered into any database or system including, but not limited to, the Oklahoma State Immunization Information System including but not limited to immunization records or immunization status, with a health care provider or health insurer without the prior written informed consent of the individual or, in the case of a minor child, the prior written informed consent of the minor child's parent or quardian.

C. If a parent or guardian has granted informed consent to the entering of immunization records or other data of such parent or guardian's minor child into any database or system including, but not limited to, the Oklahoma State Immunization Information System, the parent or guardian may, at any time, request the deletion of all immunization records or other data of the minor child from the system. Upon receipt of such a request, the Department shall promptly delete all immunization records and other data of the minor child from the system and shall delete or destroy any other files or records of the minor child stored by the Department.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
