7 An Act relating to the State Department of Education;
8 making an appropriation; making appropriation
9 nonfiscal; making appropriation exempt from certain
10 agency category and budget limits; providing an
11 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
14 Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
15 Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of Sixty
16 Million One Hundred Eighty-five Thousand Dollars (\$60,185,000.00) to
17 be transferred to the Ad Valorem Reimbursement Fund, created
18 pursuant to Section 193 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, for
19 the purpose of reimbursing counties for school districts that claim
20 a loss of revenue due to a tax exemption granted pursuant to the
21 provisions of Section 6B of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution,
22 pursuant to paragraph 8 of Section 23 of Article X of the Oklahoma
23 Constitution.

1 SECTION 2. The appropriation made by this act shall not be
2 subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for
3 encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30)
4 months from the date this act is approved.

5 SECTION 3. The appropriations made by this act shall not be
6 subject to fiscal years 2017 and 2018 agency category and budget
7 limits.

8 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective June 15, 2017.

9 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
