14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 5, Chapter 229, O.S.L.
16	2022 (74 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 9204), is amended to read as
17	follows:
18	Section 9204. A. There is hereby created until June 30, 2028,
19	the Oklahoma Broadband Office, to serve as the state's sole
20	administrator of the functions, powers, and duties assigned to the
21	Office in this act or under law. Effective June 30, 2028, the
22	Office shall terminate and all personnel positions shall be
23	abolished. The Office shall utilize the year prior to the
24	termination date for the purpose of ceasing the Office's affairs.

1 Β. The Office shall receive administrative assistance from the 2 Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES), which shall provide, through existing OMES resources, administrative assistance 3 upon request in writing or electronic correspondence from the 4 5 Office's Executive Director, within a reasonable time to allow the performance of the Office's duties or. OMES shall provide 6 assistance in the manner requested within thirty (30) days of 7 determination by the Agency that the request is able to be 8 9 fulfilled. If for any reason the request cannot be fulfilled within 10 thirty (30) days, the Office and OMES shall enter into a written 11 agreement expressing an agreed upon timeline for fulfilling the 12 needs of the Office. In the event that the request cannot be 13 fulfilled, OMES shall respond in writing within ten (10) days of the request providing reasons why the request cannot be fulfilled the 14 reasoning for denial. If the request cannot be fulfilled utilizing 15 existing resources, OMES may charge the Office for the actual cost 16 17 to fulfill the request. The Office shall be governed by the Broadband Governing 18 С. Board, created pursuant to Section 3 of this act. 19 The Office shall be advised by the Broadband Expansion 20 D. Council, created pursuant to Section 4 of this act. 21 Ε. The Office shall have an Executive Director who shall 22 oversee the operations of the Office including, but not limited to: 23 24

Overseeing the creation, maintenance, and completion of the
 Statewide Broadband Plan;

3 2. Communicating the state's progress in achieving the goals4 and implementation of the Statewide Broadband Plan;

5 3. The creation, housing, and updating of a statewide broadband6 services map;

7 4. Overseeing of grant applications and awards for connectivity
8 and affordability projects;

9 5. Making recommendations to the Board regarding procedural and10 administrative rules for the Office; and

Employment and management of Office staff subject to the
 limitations and requirements of this act and subject to the
 limitations and requirements of the Broadband Governing Board.

F. The Executive Director shall regularly report to the Council and the Board and shall submit an annual report to the Office of the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Office of the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate.

18 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 19 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
