An Act relating to the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma; allowing the Department to purchase through General Services Administration contracts; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Military Department of the State of Oklahoma

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 233.13 of Title 44, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma shall be authorized to purchase products which are available through a General Services Administration contract. Such products shall not be required to be on a current state contract before a purchase can be made.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
