SENATE BILL NO. 872 By: Newhouse

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to health information; directing the Governor to declare certain entity pursuant to federal law for certain purpose; directing State Commissioner of Health to make certain recommendations; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-133 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Governor shall declare a statewide "Qualified State-Designated Entity", pursuant to 42 U.S.C., Section 300jj-33, for the purpose of fostering the secure, effective and efficient exchange of electronic health information that leverages existing regional and state efforts and is based on standards and certification criteria adopted by the United States Department of Health and Human Services within any time limit applicable for available federal funding to support such infrastructure.

2	evaluate and make recommendations to the Governor regarding
3	designation of a qualified state-designated entity.
4	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
