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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1024.4, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 1024.4. Upon conviction of the accused, any magistrate <u>,</u>
17	law enforcement officer, law enforcement agency or district attorney
18	shall cause any obscene material or child pornography, in respect
19	whereof the accused stands convicted and which remains in the
20	possession or control of such magistrate, law enforcement officer,
21	law enforcement agency or district attorney, to be destroyed
22	including, but not limited to, the destruction of any computer, hard
23	drive or other electronic storage media on which such obscene
24	material or child pornography was located. For purposes of this

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section, "final conviction" includes the exhaustion of or failure to

    timely pursue post-conviction and state and federal habeas corpus

        SECTION 2. REPEALER 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1024, is

    hereby repealed.
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        SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
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
