NEW LAW 14 15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-124 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 16 Agricultural motor vehicles engaged in intrastate commerce 17 Α. shall be exempt from the requirement for electronic logging devices 18 and hours of services as mandated by Section 32301(b) of the U.S. 19 20 Commercial Motor Vehicle Safety Enhancement Act. For the purposes of this section, agricultural vehicles 21 shall include, but are not limited to, single axel trucks with a 22 goose neck or bumper pull trailer for the purpose of hauling horses 23

or livestock, and trailers with living quarters.

2	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
3	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
4	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
5	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
