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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Military Department;  
8 amending 44 O.S. 2011, Section 232, which relates to  
9 youth programs; modifying certain programs;  
10 authorizing the Adjutant General to enter into  
11 certain agreements; providing an effective date; and  
12 declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 44 O.S. 2011, Section 232, is  
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 44-232. A. Pursuant to rules promulgated by the  
17 Adjutant General of the State of Oklahoma, the Oklahoma Military  
18 Department is authorized to establish and operate youth programs  
19 utilizing National Guard or state-owned facilities, state-owned  
20 vehicles and civilian or National Guard personnel to provide  
21 military-styled training and other benefits to civilian youth  
22 pursuant to agreement with federal, state and local governmental  
23 agencies.

24 B. The Adjutant General is authorized further to enter into  
agreements and to do all things deemed necessary or incidental to

1 the performance of any duty authorized by subsection A of this  
2 section, including, but not limited to:

3 1. The execution of memoranda of agreement for assistance to  
4 federal, state and local governmental agencies;

5 2. The execution of grant agreements;

6 3. The execution of grant agreements with the federal  
7 government;

8 4. The execution of agreements with the federal government for  
9 reimbursement to the Oklahoma Military Department for the use and  
10 operation of Oklahoma Military Department state-owned vehicles and  
11 equipment in support of youth programs;

12 ~~4.~~ 5. The execution of other contracts and agreements; and

13 ~~5.~~ 6. The expenditure of Oklahoma Military Department funds for  
14 the purpose of advertising.

15 C. The Adjutant General is hereby authorized to accept gifts or  
16 donations for and on behalf of the state to be used for the use and  
17 benefit of the youth programs authorized by this section and their  
18 participants. The Oklahoma Military Department is directed to  
19 maintain and preserve appropriate records for all gifts made to the  
20 state pursuant to this section.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.

22 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
