

1 district for inspection by parents and guardians of the student who
2 will be involved with the class, program or test, survey or
3 questionnaire. Such curriculum, materials, classes, programs,
4 tests, surveys or questionnaires shall include information about
5 consent and shall have as one of its primary purposes the teaching
6 of or informing students about the practice of abstinence. For the
7 purposes of this section, "consent" shall have the same meaning as
8 that provided by Section 113 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
9 The superintendent or a designee of the school district shall
10 provide prior written notification to the parents or guardians of
11 the students involved of their right to inspect the curriculum and
12 material and of their obligation to notify the school in writing if
13 they do not want their child to participate in the class, program,
14 test, survey or questionnaire. Each local board of education shall
15 determine the means of providing written notification to the parents
16 and guardian which will ensure effective notice in an efficient and
17 appropriate manner. No student shall be required to participate in
18 a sex education class or program which discusses sexual behavior or
19 attitudes if a parent or guardian of the student objects in writing
20 to such participation. If the type of program referred to in this
21 section is a part of or is taught during a credit course, a student
22 may be required to enroll in the course but shall not be required to
23 receive instruction in or participate in the program if a parent or
24 guardian objects in writing.

1 B. The superintendent or a designee of a school district in
2 which sex education is taught or a program is offered which is
3 designed for the exclusive purpose of discussing sexual behavior or
4 attitudes shall approve all curriculum and materials which will be
5 used for such education and any test, survey or questionnaire whose
6 primary purpose is to elicit responses on sexual behavior or
7 attitudes used in the school prior to their use in the classroom or
8 school. The teacher involved in the class, program, testing or
9 survey shall submit the curriculum, materials, tests or surveys to
10 the superintendent or a designee for approval prior to their use in
11 the classroom or school. This section shall not apply to those
12 students enrolled in classes, programs, testings or surveys offered
13 through an alternative education program.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

15 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
