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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 11-105.1, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 11-105.1. A. All curriculum and materials including
19	supplementary materials which will be used to teach or will be used
20	for or in connection with a sex education class or program which is
21	designed for the exclusive purpose of discussing sexual behavior or
22	attitudes, or any test, survey or questionnaire whose primary
23	purpose is to elicit responses on sexual behavior or attitudes shall
24	be available through the superintendent or a designee of the school

1 district for inspection by parents and quardians of the student who 2 will be involved with the class, program or test, survey or 3 questionnaire. Such curriculum, materials, classes, programs, 4 tests, surveys or questionnaires shall include information about 5 consent and shall have as one of its primary purposes the teaching 6 of or informing students about the practice of abstinence. For the purposes of this section, "consent" shall have the same meaning as 7 that provided by Section 113 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes. 8 9 The superintendent or a designee of the school district shall 10 provide prior written notification to the parents or guardians of 11 the students involved of their right to inspect the curriculum and 12 material and of their obligation to notify the school in writing if 13 they do not want their child to participate in the class, program, test, survey or questionnaire. Each local board of education shall 14 15 determine the means of providing written notification to the parents and quardian which will ensure effective notice in an efficient and 16 appropriate manner. No student shall be required to participate in 17 a sex education class or program which discusses sexual behavior or 18 attitudes if a parent or guardian of the student objects in writing 19 to such participation. If the type of program referred to in this 20 section is a part of or is taught during a credit course, a student 21 may be required to enroll in the course but shall not be required to 22 receive instruction in or participate in the program if a parent or 23 24 guardian objects in writing.

1 The superintendent or a designee of a school district in в. 2 which sex education is taught or a program is offered which is 3 designed for the exclusive purpose of discussing sexual behavior or attitudes shall approve all curriculum and materials which will be 4 5 used for such education and any test, survey or questionnaire whose 6 primary purpose is to elicit responses on sexual behavior or 7 attitudes used in the school prior to their use in the classroom or The teacher involved in the class, program, testing or 8 school. 9 survey shall submit the curriculum, materials, tests or surveys to 10 the superintendent or a designee for approval prior to their use in 11 the classroom or school. This section shall not apply to those 12 students enrolled in classes, programs, testings or surveys offered 13 through an alternative education program. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019. 14 15 SECTION 3.
