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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 11-105.1, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 11-105.1. A. All curriculum and materials including
16	supplementary materials which will be used to teach or will be used
17	for or in connection with a sex education class or program which is
18	designed for the exclusive purpose of discussing sexual behavior or
19	attitudes, or any test, survey or questionnaire whose primary
20	purpose is to elicit responses on sexual behavior or attitudes shall
21	be available through the superintendent or a designee of the school
22	district for inspection by parents and guardians of the student who
23	will be involved with the class, program or test, survey or
24 2 -	questionnaire. Such curriculum, materials, classes, programs,

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1 tests, surveys or questionnaires shall have as one of its primary 2 purposes the teaching of or informing students about the practice of 3 abstinence. The superintendent or a designee of the school district 4 shall provide prior written notification to the parents or guardians 5 of the students involved of their right to inspect the curriculum 6 and material and of their obligation to notify the school in writing 7 if they do not want their child to participate in the class, 8 program, test, survey or questionnaire. Each local board of 9 education shall determine the means of providing written 10 notification to the parents and guardian which will ensure effective 11 notice in an efficient and appropriate manner. No student shall be 12 required to participate in a sex education class or program which 13 discusses sexual behavior or attitudes if a parent or quardian of 14 the student objects in writing to such participation. If the type 15 of program referred to in this section is a part of or is taught 16 during a credit course, a student may be required to enroll in the 17 course but shall not be required to receive instruction in or 18 participate in the program if a parent or guardian objects in 19 writing.

B. <u>Curriculum, materials, classes, programs, tests, surveys or</u> questionnaires provided to students pursuant to this section shall include information about consent. "Consent" shall have the same meaning as that provided by Section 113 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

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1	<u>C.</u> The superintendent or a designee of a school district in
2	which sex education is taught or a program is offered which is
3	designed for the exclusive purpose of discussing sexual behavior or
4	attitudes shall approve all curriculum and materials which will be
5	used for such education and any test, survey or questionnaire whose
6	primary purpose is to elicit responses on sexual behavior or
7	attitudes used in the school prior to their use in the classroom or
8	school. The teacher involved in the class, program, testing or
9	survey shall submit the curriculum, materials, tests or surveys to
10	the superintendent or a designee for approval prior to their use in
11	the classroom or school. This section shall not apply to those
12	students enrolled in classes, programs, testings or surveys offered
13	through an alternative education program.
14	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.
15	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
17	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
