21 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause, and entire bill
22 and insert:

23 "An Act relating to aeronautics technology; creating
24 the Oklahoma Aircraft Engine Testing Development
Grant Program; providing short title; allowing
certain commission to oversee certain grant program;
providing entities eligible to receive grant monies;
providing certain conditions certain entities must
meet to be eligible for grant program; stating
conditions to be eliminated from consideration;
directing certain director to promulgate rules and
procedures of program; creating Oklahoma Aircraft
Engine Testing Development Grant Program Revolving

1 Fund; providing for codification; providing an
2 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

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4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

5 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 501 of Title 3, unless there is
7 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma
9 Aircraft Engine Testing Development Grant Program".

10 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 502 of Title 3, unless there is
12 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 A. There is hereby created within the Oklahoma Aeronautics
14 Commission, the Oklahoma Aircraft Engine Testing Development Grant
15 Program to offer financial assistance by grant to private or public
16 entities for the purpose of augmenting the aircraft engine testing
17 capabilities of this state and developing aircraft engine testing
18 infrastructure. Grant funding shall be administered based on merit
19 and the potential for a specific project to enhance the aviation and
20 aerospace industry of this state. A grant under this program shall
21 be a one-time award.

22 B. Public, private, and nonprofit entities within Oklahoma that
23 have sufficient financial and management capacity to complete the
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1 requested project are eligible for funding under this program.

2 Applicants shall provide the following information:

3 1. Airline or industry support as evidenced by a letter or
4 other communication directly from the entity stating its support for
5 the project;

6 2. The ability to provide a minimum of forty percent (40%)
7 matching funds for the project; and

8 3. A proposal summary that shall include any background
9 information or history with aircraft engine testing and development,
10 project description, timeline for completion of project, and
11 estimated budget for the entire project.

12 C. A grant agreement shall be required between the awardee and
13 the Commission to provide for conditions of disbursement of grant
14 funds including obligation to repay funds if the terms of the
15 agreement are not met as well as providing ongoing quarterly reports
16 detailing activity related to the project.

17 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 503 of Title 3, unless there is
19 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
21 for the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission to be designated the
22 "Oklahoma Aircraft Engine Testing Development Grant Program
23 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject
24 to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received

1 by any public or private donations, contributions and gifts received
2 for the benefit of the fund, and any amounts appropriated by the
3 Legislature. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are
4 hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma
5 Aeronautics Commission for the purpose of funding grants as provided
6 in this act. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
7 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
8 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
9 Services for approval and payment.

10 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

11 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."

1 A. There is hereby created within the Oklahoma Aeronautics
2 Commission, the Oklahoma Aircraft Engine Testing Development Grant

4 entities for the purpose of augmenting the aircraft engine testing
5 capabilities of this state and developing aircraft engine testing
6 infrastructure. Grant funding shall be administered based on merit
7 and the potential for a specific project to enhance the aviation and
8 aerospace industry of this state. A grant under this program shall
9 be a one-time award.

10 B. Public, private, and nonprofit entities within Oklahoma that
11 have sufficient financial and management capacity to complete the
12 requested project are eligible for funding under this program.
13 Applicants shall provide the following information:

14 1. Airline or industry support as evidenced by a letter or
15 other communication directly from the entity stating its support for
16 the project;

21 SECTION 9. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
22 Aircraft Engine Testing Development Grant Program Revolving Fund
23 from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue
24 Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022,

1 the sum of Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) or so much
2 thereof as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of the fund.

3 SECTION 10. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

4 SECTION 11. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
