6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; requiring the
8 director of every state agency to notify the
9 Legislature in writing regarding certain salary
10 increases; establishing exception; providing
11 codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 846 of Title 74, unless there is
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 1. The Director of each state agency shall notify the
17 Legislature in every instance in which a state employee receives a
18 salary increase greater than two percent (2%). Written notice shall
19 be provided to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and Speaker
20 of the House of Representatives no fewer than thirty (30) business
21 days prior to the authorization of any such pay increase including
22 the following information:

- 23 a. the name and title of the employee,
24 b. the percentage increase of the employee's salary,

- 1 c. the employee's annual salary prior to, and after, the
2 approved salary increase, and
3 d. the reason for the salary increase;

4 2. No additional personal information regarding a state
5 employee shall be included in such notice; and

6 3. The provisions of this section shall apply to any
7 classified, unclassified or exempt employee of the state, excluding
8 members of boards and commissions, institutions under the
9 administrative authority of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher
10 Education, and employees of public school districts.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
