11                   An Act relating to memorial highway and bridge  
12                   designations; designating the Cecil O. Peters  
13                   Memorial Bridge; designating the Senator J. Berry  
14                   Harrison Memorial Bridge; designating The Honorable  
15                   Leonard Earl Sullivan Memorial Bridge; designating  
16                   the Steven J. Ronio Memorial Bridge; amending Section  
17                   20, Chapter 356, O.S.L. 2022 (69 O.S. Supp. 2022,  
18                   Section 1698.383), which relates to the William Mark  
19                   Miller Memorial Highway; modifying location;  
20                   providing for codification; and providing an  
21                   effective date.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23                   SECTION 1.           NEW LAW           A new section of law to be codified  
24                   in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.403 of Title 69, unless  
25                   there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

26                   The bridge on U.S. Highway 70 over the Kiamichi River adjacent  
27                   to Hugo Dam in the town of Sawyer in Choctaw County shall be  
28                   designated as the "Cecil O. Peters Memorial Bridge". The Department

1 of Transportation shall cause suitable markers bearing that name to  
2 be placed on the bridge.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.404 of Title 69, unless  
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge over Salt Creek on State Highway 18 south of Fairfax  
7 in Osage County shall be designated as the "Senator J. Berry  
8 Harrison Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall  
9 cause suitable markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

10 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.405 of Title 69, unless  
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The bridge crossing over State Highway 102 North on Interstate  
14 40 in Pottawatomie County shall be designated as "The Honorable  
15 Leonard Earl Sullivan Memorial Bridge". The Department of  
16 Transportation shall cause suitable markers bearing that name to be  
17 placed on the bridge.

18 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.406 of Title 69, unless  
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The bridge on U.S. Highway 62 crossing over Sheridan Road in  
22 Comanche County shall be designated as the "Steven J. Ronio Memorial  
23 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable  
24 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

1 SECTION 5. AMENDATORY Section 20, Chapter 356, O.S.L.  
2 2022 (69 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 1698.383), is amended to read as  
3 follows:

4 Section 1698.383. The section of Interstate 44 beginning one-  
5 half (0.5) mile ~~north~~ south of the State Highway 36 interchange  
6 extending ~~south~~ north to the U.S. Highway 70 interchange in Cotton  
7 County shall be designated as the "William Mark Miller Memorial  
8 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable  
9 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
