L5	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 5-139, is

L7	Section 5-139. School districts shall make payroll deductions
18	for either or both professional organization dues and political
L9	contributions upon <u>at</u> the <u>written</u> request of any school employee and
20	shall transmit deducted funds to the organization designated by the
21	school district employee. Such deductions shall be on a ten-month
22	basis unless otherwise designated by the employee organization.
23	However, a school employee may request at any time in writing at any

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1 immediately terminate or initiate payroll deductions to a professional organization. Upon receipt of a any written request, 2 3 the school district shall within five (5) business days or by the next pay period, whichever is earlier, terminate or initiate any 4 future payroll deductions of the requesting school employee to a 5 professional organization. Upon receipt of a written request, the 6 school district shall notify the professional organization of the 7 initiation or termination of payroll deductions within fifteen (15) 9 business days. If the request is to terminate a deduction, the 10 school district shall not make any advance payments to any 11 professional organization of any future dues on behalf of the school 12 employee. No school district policy or negotiated agreement shall place any other conditions or requirements, including but not 13 limited to personal hand delivery, upon any employee to initiate or 14 terminate any payroll deduction to a professional organization 15 16 except for a written request as outlined in this section. school district policy or provision in a negotiated agreement that 17 places additional conditions or requirements on initiation or 18 termination beyond those outlined in this section shall be null and 19 void. A school district which fails to terminate payroll deductions 20 for an employee in accordance with this section shall immediately 21 reimburse the employee the amount of all payroll deductions made by 22 the school district after the employee's request, and the amount due 23 24 the employee shall double every thirty (30) days until paid in full.

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SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.
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        SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
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    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
