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9	An Act relating to school employees; amending 70 O.S. 2011, Section 5-139, which relates to professional organization dues; requiring certain request to be written; prohibiting a school district policy or negotiated agreement from placing certain conditions to initiate or terminate certain payroll deduction; requiring a school district to reimburse certain deductions made after certain request; providing an
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13	effective date; and declaring an emergency.
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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 5-139, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	Section 5-139. School districts shall make payroll deductions
20	for either or both professional organization dues and political
21	contributions upon at the written request of any school employee and
22	shall transmit deducted funds to the organization designated by the
23	school district employee. Such deductions shall be on a ten-month
24	basis unless otherwise designated by the employee organization.

1 However, a school employee may request at any time in writing at any 2 time, including by email or fax, for the school district to 3 immediately terminate or initiate payroll deductions to a 4 professional organization. Upon receipt of a any written request, 5 the school district shall within five (5) business days or by the next pay period, whichever is earlier, terminate or initiate any 6 7 future payroll deductions of the requesting school employee to a professional organization. Upon receipt of a written request, the 8 9 school district shall notify the professional organization of the 10 initiation or termination of payroll deductions within fifteen (15) 11 business days. If the request is to terminate a deduction, the 12 school district shall not make any advance payments to any professional organization of any future dues on behalf of the school 13 No school district policy or negotiated agreement shall 14 employee. place any other conditions or requirements, including but not 15 16 limited to personal hand delivery, upon any employee to initiate or terminate any payroll deduction to a professional organization 17 except for a written request as outlined in this section. Any 18 school district policy or provision in a negotiated agreement that 19 places additional conditions or requirements on initiation or 20 termination beyond those outlined in this section shall be null and 21 void. A school district which fails to terminate payroll deductions 22 23 for an employee in accordance with this section shall immediately 24 reimburse the employee the amount of all payroll deductions made by

1	the school district after the employee's request, and the amount due
2	the employee shall double every thirty (30) days until paid in full.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.
4	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
