12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 13 O.S. 2011, Section 176.2, is

14	Section 176.2. As used in the Security of Communications Act:
15	1. "Aggrieved person" means a person who was a party to any
16	intercepted wire, oral or electronic communication or a person
17	against whom the interception was directed;
18	2. "Aural acquisition" means obtaining knowledge of a
19	communication through the sense of hearing which is contemporaneous
20	with the communication;
21	3. "Aural transfer" means a transfer containing the human voice
22	at any point between and including the point of origin and the point
23	of reception;

4. "Communication common carrier" means, for the purposes of
 the Security of Communications Act only, any telephone or telegraph
 company, rural telephone cooperative, communications transmission
 company or other public communications company under the laws of
 this state;

6 5. "Communication facility" means any and all public and
7 private instrumentalities used or useful in the transmission of
8 writing, signs, signals, pictures, or sounds of all kinds and
9 includes mail, telephone, wire, radio, and all other means of
10 communication;

6. "Contents", when used with respect to any wire, oral or electronic communication, includes any information concerning the substance, purport or meaning of that communication;

14 7. "Electronic communication" means any transfer of signs,
15 signals, writing, images, sounds, data, or intelligence of any
16 nature transmitted in whole or in part by a wire, radio,
17 electromagnetic, photoelectronic or photooptical photo optical
18 system, but does not include:

19 a. any wire or oral communication,

8. "Electronic, mechanical or other device" means any device or
 apparatus which can be used to intercept a wire, oral or electronic
 communication other than:

any telephone or telegraph instrument, equipment or 4 a. 5 facility or any component thereof furnished to the subscriber or user by a communication common carrier 6 or other lawful supplier in the ordinary course of its 7 business which is being used by the subscriber or user 8 9 in the ordinary course of its business, or being used 10 by a communication common carrier in the ordinary 11 course of business or being used by a law enforcement officer in the ordinary course of duties, or 12 b. a hearing aid or similar device being used to correct 13

9. "Intercept" means the aural acquisition of the contents of any wire, oral or electronic communication through the use of any electronic, mechanical or other device;

19 of the Court of Criminal Appeals <u>or any other Judge of the Court of</u>

Act or similar federal offenses and any attorney authorized by law
 to prosecute or participate in the prosecution of such offenses;

3 12. "Oral communication" means any communication uttered by a 4 person exhibiting an expectation that such communication is not 5 subject to interception under circumstance justifying such 6 expectation;

7 13. "Person" means any individual, partnership, association, 8 joint-stock company, trust, corporation or political subdivision 9 including an employee or agent thereof; and

10 14. "Wire communication" means any aural transfer made in whole or in part through the use of facilities for the transmission of 11 12 communications by the aid of wire, cable or other like connection 13 between the point of origin and the point of reception, including the use of such connection in a switching station, furnished or 14 operated by any person engaged in providing or operating such 15 facilities for the transmission of intrastate, interstate or foreign 16 communications or communications affecting intrastate, interstate or 17 foreign commerce. 18

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
