2 thereof having responsibility for the investigation of the offense
3 as to which the application is made, when such interception may
4 provide evidence of acts of biochemical terrorism, terrorism,
5 terrorism hoax, and biochemical assault, as defined in Section
6 1268.1 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the commission of the
7 offense of murder, the cultivation or manufacture or distribution of
8 narcotic drugs or other controlled dangerous substances, as defined
9 in the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act, trafficking in
10 illegal drugs, as defined in the Trafficking in Illegal Drugs Act,
11 the trafficking of humans for labor or for commercial sex, as
12 defined in Section 748 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the
13 pandering of humans for sex as provided in Section 1081 of Title 21
14 of the Oklahoma Statutes or the prostitution of a child, as defined
15 in Section 1030 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, child sexual
16 exploitation or permitting child sexual exploitation as defined in
17 Section 843.5 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, soliciting
18 sexual conduct or communication with a minor by use of technology as
19 defined in Section 1040.13a of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
20 and any conspiracy to commit the crimes specifically enumerated in
21 this section.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
