7	An Act relating to virtual charter schools; requiring

10	statewide virtual charter school that has not complied with certain plan for certain number of

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-145.9 of Title 70, unless
19	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. If the graduation rate of a statewide virtual charter school
21	is ten (10) percentage points or more below the average graduation
22	rate for public schools in this state, as determined by the State
23	Department of Education, the statewide virtual charter school shall

submit to the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board a report that

includes an analysis of its graduation rate, including a plan to
improve its rate to the state average. The report shall be
submitted by July 1 of each year and shall be filed each year until
the statewide virtual charter school's graduation rate is fewer than
ten (10) percentage points below the state average graduation rate
for public schools. The Statewide Virtual Charter School Board
shall publish the reports on its website.
```

- B. If the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board determines that for three (3) consecutive years the statewide virtual charter school is not significantly complying with its reported plan to improve its graduation rate, the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board may deny the statewide virtual charter school's application for renewal of contract.
- c. If the graduation rate of a statewide virtual charter school is twenty (20) percentage points or more below the average graduation rate for public schools in this state for three (3) consecutive years, the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board shall deny the statewide virtual charter school's application for renewal of contract.
- 20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
