12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
14	last amended by Section 2, Chapter 378, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
15	2015, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:
16	Section 1135.5. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
17	authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
18	plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
19	financial assistance as provided by this section.
20	Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
21	person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
22	ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
23	on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
24	registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

1 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax 2 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall 3 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. 4 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain 5 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor 6 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be 7 issued on a staggered system.

The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 8 9 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept 10 applications for special license plates authorized under this The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 11 section. 12 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 13 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 14 15 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 16 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 17 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 18 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. 19

If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1, 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license 1 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration 2 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be 3 removed from the vehicle.

For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, 4 5 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid 6 7 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the 8 9 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall 10 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are 11 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time 12 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

B. The special license plates provided by this section are as follows:

University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide

1 general public environmental education program created pursuant to Such 2 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. 3 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for 4 5 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated 6 7 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by 8 9 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in 10 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned 11 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

12 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid. 13 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four 14 15 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an 16 17 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 18 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 19 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any 20 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may 21 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated 22 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon 23 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire 24

 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and Living Memorial;

Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be 8 4. 9 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax 10 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in 11 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any 12 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in 13 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may 14 15 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license 16 plates.

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child

Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
 the prevention of child abuse.

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected4 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

5 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to 6 7 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers 8 9 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized 10 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States 11 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if 12 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United 13 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or 14 15 The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not design. more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate 16 17 issued;

7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother

Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
 Oklahoma;

9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be
designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

12 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency 13 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical 14 15 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying 16 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in 17 consultation with the state association of emergency medical 18 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee 19 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Technician 20 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes; 22

23 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
 24 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of

1 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount 2 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act 3 Revolving Fund;

Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall 4 12. 5 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 6 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates 7 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected 8 9 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for 10 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to 11 12 provide services to crime victims;

13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates 13 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 14 15 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The 16 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of 17 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -18 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to 19 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program; 20

14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued

1 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in 2 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to 3 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in 4 Section 1104.4 of this title;

5 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall 6 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax 7 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued 8 9 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag 10 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an 11 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in 12 Section 1104.3 of this title;

16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates 13 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate 14 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. 15 The 16 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 17 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be 18 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial 19 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of 20 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes; 21

17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
by the State Department of Education in consultation with the

Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as follows:

- 7 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
 8 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 9 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
 10 Education Revolving Fund,
- c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
 Career Technology Fund, and
- d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
 Oklahoma Statutes.

However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this paragraph;

18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the

legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the 1 2 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as 3 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in 4 5 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown. 6 emblem. 7 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 8 9 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any 10 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the 11 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 12 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired 13 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the 14 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund; 15

Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such 16 19. plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to 17 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall 18 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters 19 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. 20 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. 21 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into 22 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any 23 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts 24

1 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide 2 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty 3 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such 4 5 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the 6 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and 7 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and 8 9 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 10 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5 11 12 of this title;

13 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax 14 15 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma 16 17 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation 18 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and 19 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks; 20

21 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates 22 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of 23 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for 24 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive

1 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and 2 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates 3 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human 4 5 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury 6 7 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act 8 9 specifically for created families;

As provided in this section, an 22 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in 23 Section 1104.7 of this title; 24

1 25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed 2 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions 3 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, 4 5 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation 6 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association 7 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter 8 9 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service 10 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars 11 12 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be 13 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission 14 15 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person 16 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's 17 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section, 18 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in 19 Section 1104.8 of this title; 20

21 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
22 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
23 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
24 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person

1 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of 2 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. 3 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a 4 5 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use 6 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. 7 The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts 8 9 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout 10 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license 11 plate issued;

12 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to 13 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. 14 The plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City 15 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter 16 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon 17 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the 18 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing 19 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial 20 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license 21 plate issued; 22

23 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
24 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The

1 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic 2 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be 3 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed 4 30. 5 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. 6 The 7 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be 8 9 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty 10 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma 11 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

12 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for 13 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational 14 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in 15 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty 16 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the 17 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet 18 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the 19 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in 20 Section 1104.10 of this title; 21

32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who

are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be 7 33. designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma 8 9 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma 10 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States 11 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on 12 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any 13 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be 14 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in 15 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes; 16

34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plates -17 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to 18 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. 19 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers 20 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized 21 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls 22 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter 23 24 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America

for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plates - such plates shall 6 35. 7 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be 8 9 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse 10 Association. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee 11 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.12 of this title; 12

36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such 13 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 14 15 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to 16 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and 17 letters from one to maximum of seven, as for personalized license 18 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected 19 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License 20 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title; 21 37. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be 22

23 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma 24 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with 1 the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. As provided in this section, 2 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma 3 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.13 of this 4 title;

5 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued 6 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes 7 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects, premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be 8 9 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes. 10 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be 11 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and 12 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title; Support Our Troops Supporter License Plates - such plates 13 39. shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 14 15 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from 16 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official 17 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark 18 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax 19 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with 20 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be 21 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or 22 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to 23

Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
 each license plate issued;
