7 A Concurrent Resolution relating to adjournment of
8 the Legislature for a period in excess of three days;
9 and providing reciprocal consent of the Senate and
10 the House of Representatives to adjourn for a period
of time in excess of three days for the duration of
the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma
Legislature.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article V, Section 30 of the Oklahoma
Constitution, there is a requirement for consent of the two chambers
of the Legislature to be adjourned for a period of time in excess of
three (3) days; and

WHEREAS, it is foreseeable that either the Senate or the House
of Representatives or both chambers of the Legislature may need to
adjourn for a period of time of more than three (3) days between the
current point of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma
Legislature and the sine die adjournment of such session; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of time and to avoid potential
difficulty in obtaining the required assent pursuant to Article V,
Section 30 of the Oklahoma Constitution, it is reasonable for the

1 Legislature to provide a continuing permission for either chamber or
2 both chambers to be adjourned for a period of time in excess of
3 three (3) days.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND
5 EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF
6 REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

7 THAT the Senate grants its consent to the House of
8 Representatives, and the House of Representatives grants its consent
9 to the Senate, to be adjourned for more than three (3) days from the
10 date of adoption of this measure by the chambers or the date as of
11 which the measure is acted upon by the second chamber to consider
12 it, whichever date last occurs.

13 THAT the ongoing mutual consent to adjournment for a period of
14 time in excess of three (3) days as provided by this measure shall
15 continue until this measure is either superseded by other action
16 taken by the Legislature or until the sine die adjournment of the
17 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature,
18 whichever event first occurs.
