L 8	of Representatives or both chambers of the Legislature may need to

22	WHEREAS, in the interest of time and to avoid potential
23	difficulty in obtaining the required assent pursuant to Article V,

Section 30 of the Oklahoma Constitution, it is reasonable for the

Legislature to provide a continuing permission for either chamber or both chambers to be adjourned for a period of time in excess of three (3) days.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Senate grants its consent to the House of Representatives, and the House of Representatives grants its consent to the Senate, to be adjourned for more than three (3) days from the date of adoption of this measure by the chambers or the date as of which the measure is acted upon by the second chamber to consider it, whichever date last occurs.

THAT the ongoing mutual consent to adjournment for a period of time in excess of three (3) days as provided by this measure shall continue until this measure is either superseded by other action taken by the Legislature or until the sine die adjournment of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, whichever event first occurs.
