1 ENGROSSED SENATE CONCURRENT 2 RESOLUTION NO. 11 By: Brown of the Senate 3 and Sears of the House 4 5 6 A Concurrent Resolution supporting undergraduate research and creative scholarly activities at 7 universities in Oklahoma; declaring Oklahoma Research Day in the state; and directing distribution. 8 9 WHEREAS, many students and faculty at colleges and universities 10 11 throughout Oklahoma pursue undergraduate research and creative 12 scholarly activities each year in all disciplines; and WHEREAS, undergraduate research promotes critical thinking, 13 creativity, problem-solving, self-confidence and intellectual 14 15 independence; and WHEREAS, students who participate in undergraduate research with 16 faculty have higher retention and graduation rates, and ninety 17 percent of those graduates stay in the State of Oklahoma, 18 expressively supporting the Complete College America initiative; and 19 WHEREAS, students who participate in undergraduate research with 20 faculty increase their employability and the post-graduate well-21 being of themselves, their families, and their communities; and 22 WHEREAS, the ability to graduate and retain a workforce able to 23 think critically and creatively plays an essential role in helping 24

1 to meet the challenges and capitalize on opportunities, ensuring 2 continued growth and a brighter future for Oklahoma; and 3 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, the 4 Oklahoma IDeA Network for Biomedical Research Excellence (INBRE), 5 the National Science Foundation (NSF) and Oklahoma Regional 6 Universities have sponsored Research Day for the past 15 years, 7 involving thousands of faculty and students from across our state, with this year being hosted by Northeastern State University. 9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION 10 OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN: 11 12 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature supports and encourages 13 undergraduate scholarly activities at universities in Oklahoma. THAT the Oklahoma Legislature hereby designates March 13, 2015, 14 15 as Oklahoma Research Day in the State of Oklahoma. THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the President 16 of Northeastern State University and the members of the Boards of 17 the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and the Regents of 18 the Regional University System of Oklahoma. 19 20 21 22
