The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for 17 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, 18 the following proposed amendment to Section 15 of Article IX of the 19 Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows: 20 Section 15. A. A Corporation Commission is hereby created, to 21 be composed of three five persons, who three of whom shall be 22 elected by the people at a general election for State officers, and 23

their with terms of office shall be of six (6) years, and two of

whom shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent

of the Senate, and shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor. In
case of a vacancy in said the office of an elected member, the
Governor of the State shall fill such vacancy by appointment until
the next general election, when a successor shall be elected to fill
out any unexpired term.

B. No person shall be eligible to serve as Corporation
Commissioner for a period of time in excess of twelve (12) years.
Such years need not be consecutive. Any years served by a person

- Commissioner for a period of time in excess of twelve (12) years. Such years need not be consecutive. Any years served by a person elected or appointed to serve less than a full term to fill a vacancy in such office shall not be included in the limitation set forth herein. Any person serving in such position at the time of passage of this amendment on November 2, 2010, shall be eligible to complete the term for which he or she has been elected and shall be eligible to serve an additional twelve (12) years thereafter, notwithstanding the provisions of this amendment.
- $\underline{\text{C.}}$  The Legislature is hereby authorized to enact laws to implement the provisions of this subsection.

1 This measure amends Section 15 of Article 9 of the Oklahoma 2 Constitution. This section relates to the members of the 3 Corporation Commission. Under current law, there are three 4 elected members. This measure would add two more members to be 5 appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the 6 Senate. They would serve at the pleasure of the Governor.
