7	A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or
8	rejection proposed amendments to Section 15 of Article IX of the Oklahoma Constitution, which
9	relates to the Corporation Commission; directing the Governor to appoint the members of the Corporation
10	Commission; removing eligibility and term limit provisions for the members of the Corporation
11	Commission; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

14	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
15	2ND SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
16	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
17	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
18	the following proposed amendment to Section 15 of Article IX of the
19	Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows:
20	Section 15. A. A Corporation Commission is hereby created, to
21	be composed of three persons, who shall be elected by the people at
22	a general election for State officers, and their terms of office
23	shall be six (6) years. In case of a vacancy in said office, the
24	Governor of the State shall fill such vacancy by appointment until

    the next general election, when a successor shall be elected to fill

    out any unexpired term appointed by the Governor by and with the
 3
    consent of the Senate for a term of four (4) years to run
 4
    concurrently with the term of the Governor.

        B. No person shall be eligible to serve as Corporation
    Commissioner for a period of time in excess of twelve (12) years.
 6
    Such years need not be consecutive. Any years served by a person
 7
    elected or appointed to serve less than a full term to fill a
 9
    vacancy in such office shall not be included in the limitation set
10
    forth herein. Any person serving in such position at the time of
11
    passage of this amendment shall be eligible to complete the term for
12
    which he or she has been elected and shall be eligible to serve an
13
    additional twelve (12) years thereafter, notwithstanding the
    provisions of this amendment. The Legislature is hereby authorized
14
    to enact laws to implement the provisions of this subsection.
