7	A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State
8	to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to Section 21 of
9	Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution; allowing the Board on Legislative Compensation to meet upon
10	certain event; authorizing suspension of compensation; providing ballot title; and directing
11	filing.
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14	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
15	2ND SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
16	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
17	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
18	the following proposed amendment to Section 21 of Article V of the
19	Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows:
20	Section 21. A. The Legislature shall enact laws to prohibit
21	members of the Legislature from engaging in activities or having
22	interests which conflict with the proper discharge of their duties
23	and responsibilities.
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The Board on Legislative Compensation is hereby created. Said The Board shall be composed of five members appointed by the Governor, two members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and two members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The members appointed by the Governor shall be from religious organizations, communications media, nonstatesupported educational institutions, labor organizations, and retail business; the members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall be from agricultural and civic organizations; and the members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall be from manufacturing and from professional fields not otherwise specified. No member of the Legislature may be appointed to or serve on the Board. In addition to the members above provided for, the Chairman of the Oklahoma Tax Commission and the Director of State Finance shall serve as ex officio nonvoting members of said the Board. The Chairman of said the Board shall be designated by the Governor. Members of the Legislature shall receive such compensation as shall be fixed by the Board on Legislative Compensation. If a member of the Legislature is incarcerated due to being charged with a criminal offense and subsequently is found quilty of the offense or pleads guilty or nolo contendere to the offense, the legislator shall return to the state any compensation the legislator received from the state while the legislator was incarcerated prior to the guilty verdict or plea or nolo contendere

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1 plea and shall not receive any compensation from the state during any incarceration following such verdict or plea. Said The Board 2 3 shall each two years review the compensation paid to the members of the Legislature and shall be empowered to change such compensation; 5 such change to become effective on the fifteenth day following the succeeding general election. In addition, the Board is authorized 6 7 to meet each year if the Legislature fails to comply with Section 34.86 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes for the purposes of 8 9 suspending legislator compensation on terms to be determined by the 10 Board. The members of the Board shall serve without compensation, but shall be entitled to receive necessary travel and subsistence 11 12 expense as provided by law for other state officers.

SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in the following form:

THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

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This measure amends Section 21 of Article 5 of the Oklahoma

Constitution. The change allows the Board on Legislative

Compensation to meet each year if the Legislature fails to

present full funding measures for common education to the

Governor by certain date. The compensation of legislators may

be suspended when that event occurs.
