A Resolution proclaiming April 8-14, 2018, as  
Emergency Management Week in the State of Oklahoma;  
and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, since 2007, Oklahoma has received 38 presidential  
disaster declarations representing more than \$640 million in  
infrastructure damage and millions more in private property damage  
delivered by ice and snow storms, tornadoes, flooding and other  
severe weather; and

WHEREAS, Oklahomans are adversely affected by such emergencies  
and disasters; and

WHEREAS, it is vital that we further an awareness of the dangers of such disasters and the protective measures citizens can take in the event of such conditions; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma Emergency Managers are responsible for encouraging and assisting state and local officials to plan adequately for and respond effectively to such emergencies and disasters; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma Emergency Managers follow a comprehensive plan involving the four phases of emergency management: preparedness, response, recovery and mitigation; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Emergency Management Association should be commended for its continued diligence and mission to the citizens of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma Emergency Managers from around the state will take part in Emergency Management Day on April 11, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate proclaims April 8-14, 2018, as "Emergency Management Week" in the State of Oklahoma, and encourages all Oklahomans to support emergency management by preparing their homes and families for severe weather.
