6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Resolution congratulating the Ada men's and women's
8 tennis teams on their 2016 Class 4A state
9 championships; commending the school's 20 tennis
10 state championships; applauding Head Coach Griese's
11 11 state titles; and directing distribution.

12 WHEREAS, the Ada high school tennis program has a legacy of
13 winning with 20 state championships between the men's and women's
14 teams; and

15 WHEREAS, this is the fifth straight year that either the Ada
16 men's or women's tennis team has won the state championship; and

17 WHEREAS, the Ada men won their 11th state title capturing first
18 place in both No. 2 Singles and No. 2 Doubles and taking fourth
19 place in No. 1 Singles and sixth place in No. 1 Doubles; and

20 WHEREAS, the Lady Cougars have dominated the court winning three
21 consecutive state tennis championships and their ninth state title
22 overall. The ladies took first place in No. 2 Singles as well as
23 No. 1 and No. 2 doubles and finished fourth in No. 1 Singles; and

1 WHEREAS, Ada Tennis Head Coach Skip Griese has led the Ada
2 Cougars to 11 state championships; and

3 WHEREAS, the Cougar tennis teams not only work hard on the court
4 but also in the classroom with the ladies having a cumulative G.P.A.
5 of over 3.76 and the men having a cumulative G.P.A. of over 3.79.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION
7 OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

8 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates the Ada men's and
9 women's tennis team on their 2016 Class 4A state championships.

10 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate commends the school's 20 tennis
11 state championships.

12 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate applauds Head Coach Skip Griese's
13 leadership and dedication to Ada's tennis program and helping them
