

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 966 Relating to health

SB 966 contains a wide variety of elements pertaining to the membership of the Health Insurance Exchange Advisory Committee, the repeal of the Compact of Free Association Premium Assistance Program, replaces the Health Plan Quality Metrics Committee and establishes the Metrics and Scoring committee within the Oregon Health Policy Board while clarifying compensation and reimbursement, fixes payment mechanisms within the Medicaid waiver, and directs OHA to study the Coordinated Care Organization Quality Incentive Program and the structure of reporting going forward. The -A8 amendment reverses the Health Plan Quality Metrics Committee structure changes and it provides payment mechanisms for incorporating social determinants of health as part of the 1115 demonstration waiver. It also contains the appropriation for a one-time limited duration position project manager to conduct the request for proposal and contract with a vendor with specific qualifications, as well as the costs for consultation contracts, community engagement costs, and four additional positions (1.76 FTE) to coordinate measurements and partner with CCOs on an on-going basis. The -A8 amendment adds \$552,854 General Fund, \$214,298 Other Funds limitation, and \$552,854 Federal Funds limitation for a total of \$1,320,006 total funds.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends SB 966 be amended by the -A8 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
