

House Bill 2195

Sponsored by Representative RESCHKE (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says that the state should fight antisemitism and defines it. (Flesch Readability Score: 74.8).

Finds and declares that it is the policy of this state to combat antisemitism. Defines "antisemitism."

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to antisemitism.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "antisemitism" means a perception of Jews which**
5 **may be expressed as hatred toward Jews or through rhetorical or physical manifestations**
6 **directed toward Jewish or non-Jewish individuals or their property, toward Jewish commu-**
7 **nity institutions or toward religious facilities.**

8 **(2) The Legislative Assembly finds and declares that it is the policy of this state to**
9 **combat antisemitism.**
