

# House Bill 2208

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Behavioral Health and Health Care for Representative Rob Nosse)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act makes changes to CCO health improvement plans. (Flesch Readability Score: 75.5).

Requires a community health improvement plan to serve as the primary regional planning document for all health services and operations and incorporate various other planning documents.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. ORS 414.577 is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 414.**

6 **SECTION 2. ORS 414.577 is amended to read:**

7 414.577. (1) A coordinated care organization shall collaborate with local public health authori-  
8 ties, **community mental health programs** and hospitals located in areas served by the coordinated  
9 care organization to conduct a community health assessment and adopt a community health im-  
10 provement plan, shared with and endorsed by the coordinated care organization, local public health  
11 authorities, **community mental health programs** and hospitals, to serve as a strategic population  
12 health and health care services plan for the residents of the areas served by the coordinated care  
13 organization, local public health authorities, **community mental health programs** and hospitals.  
14 The **community** health improvement plan must include strategies for achieving shared priorities.

15 **(2) The community health improvement plan shall serve as the primary regional planning**  
16 **document for all health services and operations and shall incorporate:**

17 **(a) Plans to address:**

18 **(A) Health inequities;**

19 **(B) Social determinants of health;**

20 **(C) Health technology;**

21 **(D) Payment models;**

22 **(E) Oral health integration;**

23 **(F) Language access;**

24 **(G) Traditional health worker integration and utilization; and**

25 **(H) Mental health parity analysis;**

26 **(b) Local drug and alcohol planning;**

27 **(c) Community diversion plans;**

28 **(d) Local plans adopted by local mental health authorities under ORS 430.630;**

29 **(e) Comprehensive behavioral health planning by coordinated care organizations; and**

**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter *[italic and bracketed]* is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

1           **(f) Any other health services or operations planning document prescribed by the Oregon**  
2 **Health Authority.**

3           [(2)] **(3)** The coordinated care organization shall post the **community** health improvement plan  
4 to the coordinated care organization’s website.

5           [(3)] **(4)** The [*Oregon Health*] authority may prescribe by rule requirements for **community**  
6 health improvement plans and provide guidance for aligning the timelines for the development of the  
7 community health assessments and **community** health improvement plans by coordinated care or-  
8 ganizations, local public health authorities, **community mental health programs** and hospitals.

9           **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2025 Act applies to community health improvement plans**  
10 **adopted on or after the effective date of this 2025 Act.**

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
