House Bill 2244

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells DCBS to study issues relating to workplace safety. The Act tells DCBS to submit a report by September 15 of next year. (Flesch Readability Score: 62.1).

Requires the Department of Consumer and Business Services to study issues relating to workplace safety. Directs the department to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to business and labor not later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to workplace safety.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. The Department of Consumer and Business Services shall study issues relating to workplace safety. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to business and labor no later than September 15, 2026.
 - SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
