

House Bill 2405

Sponsored by Representative LIVELY (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes State Parks and Recreation Director to adopt rules to establish standards used when department disburses moneys to tribal governments under state or federal programs and to make state funding assistance available to tribal governments for constructing and restoring memorials honoring veterans and war memorials on public property.

2 Relating to moneys provided to tribal governments by the State Parks and Recreation Department;
3 amending ORS 390.180.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 390.180 is amended to read:

6 390.180. (1) The State Parks and Recreation Director shall adopt rules that:

7 (a) Establish the standards the State Parks and Recreation Department shall use when that de-
8 partment:

9 (A) Performs comprehensive statewide recreational planning; or

10 (B) Disburses any moneys to **tribal**, regional or local governments or other state agencies under
11 programs established under state or federal law.

12 (b) Establish a process for the development of a master plan for each state park, including public
13 participation and coordination with affected local governments.

14 (c) Establish a master plan for each state park, including an assessment of resources and a de-
15 termination of the capacity for public use and enjoyment of each park, that the State Parks and
16 Recreation Department shall follow in its development and use of each park.

17 (d) Make state funding assistance available to **tribal**, regional or local governments that dem-
18 onstrate cooperation with nonprofit veterans' organizations for the construction and restoration of
19 memorials honoring veterans and war memorials located on public property.

20 (2) The State Parks and Recreation Director shall submit an adopted state park master plan to
21 the local government with land use planning responsibility for the subject park.
